### Volunteer Job Descriptions

#### Information Booth

Two volunteers will be staffing each of the 2 information booths at all times during the event. One booth will be set up at Water St and 3<sup>rd</sup> St, SE and the second booth will be set up at Water St and 4<sup>th</sup> St, SE. Volunteers will answer questions about the park and event schedule, hand out flyers, and be greeters for those coming to the event.

#### Canal Basin and Great Lawn

Two volunteers will monitor safety around the water, notify security or EMS if problems arise, answer questions and hand out flyers. On Saturday, there will also be yoga and pilates classes near the canal and the volunteer will need to ensure a walkway remains open between the classes and the canal basin.

#### Terraced Steps

Volunteers will provide a presence on the eastern side of the park, answering questions, handing out flyers, and monitoring the boardwalk and stage area.

## **Dog Run**

On Saturday, volunteers will assist in the set up of breakfast food, welcome dog owners, hand out prizes and goody-bags and remind owners to put dogs on leashes when leaving the dog run.
