CAPITOL RIVERFRONT BID SERVES UP A SUMMER FULL OF SIGNATURE EVENTS IN DC'S FASTEST GROWING COMMUNITY

THE Destination for Free Concerts, Movies, Children's Activities, Farmers Markets, and Fitness Classes Kicks off with an Ice Cream Social Spotlighting "Capitol Riverfront: Then & Now" Exhibit

The Capitol Riverfront Business Improvement District (BID) will launch another summer of vibrant programming free and open to the public with an Ice Cream Social and community celebration of the *Capitol Riverfront: Then & Now photo exhibit* on Thursday, May 30 (6:00-8:00 pm), at the southern block of Canal Park. This kick-off to summer will feature free scoops of ice cream from Altani Gelato and Ice Cream Jubilee, live acoustic music, and a Meet-and-Greet with JDLand.com creator and photographer Jacqueline Dupree, whose extensive photograph collection is featured in the exhibit.

Capitol Riverfront: Then & Now is an outdoor photo exhibit that pays homage to the neighborhood's history and celebrates its evolution from a once light industrial backyard into a vibrant mixed-use urban waterfront community. The historical photo exhibit can be viewed through mid-summer in the southern block of Canal Park, located at 200 M Street, SE, and in Yards Park, located at 355 Water Street, SE.

The Capitol Riverfront neighborhood is a place for residents, visitors, and employees to explore, connect and thrive this summer with its exciting lineup of free outdoor events, including the popular Thursday Night Movie Series, Friday Night Concert Series, Kids in Canal, Outdoor Fitness Series, and the FRESHFARM Farmers Market.

Movies: The Capitol Riverfront Outdoor Movie Series returns to the northern block of Canal Park from June 13 through August 22, located at 2nd and "Eye" Streets, SE. Each film in this year's 10-week series was selected by the public, via social media, and will roll at sundown (typically around 8:30 pm).
